The Montessori curriculum was created by Dr. Maria Montessori, an Italian educator who believed that children learn best through hands-on experiences and self-directed exploration, at their own pace.



Montessori Practitioners

Montessori practitioners act as guides, observing each child's interests and development to provide the right materials and challenges at the right time.

Unlike traditional teaching, they step back to allow children to explore independently while offering support when needed.

Everything in the classroom is child-sized and displayed on low shelves, making materials easily accessible. This set up encourages children to choose their own activities, promoting independence, self-discipline, and deep engagement in learning. What is the EYFS?

The Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS), is the national framework that defines the standards of learning, development, and care of children from birth to five years old.

The EYFS divides learning and development into seven key areas, which are further grouped into three prime areas and four specific areas outlined below:

Prime Areas



Communication and language

Learning to express thoughts, listen and communicate with others.



Physical development

Developing coordination, movement, and self-care skills.



Personal, social, and emotional development

Building confidence, friendships, and emotional well-being.

Specific Areas



Literacy

Developing reading and writing skills through books, phonics, and storytelling.



Mathematics

Understanding numbers, shapes, and problem-solving through hands-on play.



Understanding the world

Exploring nature, different cultures, and how things work.



Expressive arts & design

Encouraging creativity through music, art, and imaginative play.

How Montessori Supports the EYFS

Our unique approach meets the EYFS framework through the Montessori curriculum, which provides a hands-on, child-led way to achieve each area. We make learning engaging, exciting and appropriately challenging, helping children build a strong foundation for future success.

Language

Through activities such as the sandpaper letters and the large movable alphabets, children learn phonics, build vocabulary, and develop early reading and writing skills in a fun and interactive way.



Mathematics

Children develop a deep understanding of numbers and counting using hands-on materials like number rods and bead chains. This practical approach makes concepts like addition and subtraction easy to grasp.



Practical life skills

Everyday tasks like pouring, cleaning, and food preparation help children develop independence, coordination, and confidence in looking after themselves and their surroundings.



Cultural awareness

Children explore the world through music, stories, art, and geography. These activities help them learn about different places and cultures, building curiosity and respect for others.



Sensorial exploration

Children refine their senses by touching, sorting, and comparing objects by size, shape, texture, sound, and colour. These activities strengthen their observation skills and ability to focus.





Screening process



Our recruitment process includes two interviews and a three hour working trial. During the trial candidates are supervised carrying out an activity with the children, demonstrating their knowledge, skills and passion.

Safer recruitment and induction



Your child's safety is our top priority. Every team member passes enhanced DBS checks, provides a minimum of two satisfactory references, and completes a thorough induction with our Human Resources team prior to starting, outlining our policies, procedures, and expectations for their first three months.

Onboarding process



From day one, new staff are already trained in:

- Basic First Aid
- Safeguarding Children (Level 2)
- Food Safety & Hygiene (Level 2)

During their Manager's induction, they are provided with a clear training plan, ensuring they receive top-tier support from our experienced team. They are then paired up with a mentor, typically the room manager, who will gradually train them up on our Little Learners ways of working.

Ongoing development and career progression



Many of our leaders began as assistants, developing their expertise through training, mentoring, and hands-on experience. This provides consistency and stability in our team, further enhancing our strong team culture, as well as motivating others to develop their skills. FAQs

How do you support my child settle into the nursery?

We offer a settling in period, allowing your child to gradually adjust to the environment and build relationships with staff and other children. Whilst they are settling, we carry out a 1-1 consultation with you to best understand their unique interests and needs, so that we can

plan engaging activities around them.

- What is your policy on sickness?

 To ensure the health and safety of all children, parents are asked to keep their child at home if they are unwell, especially if they have a fever, diarrhoea, or any contagious illness. If a child becomes ill while in our care, our nursery will contact the parents and may require the child to be collected.
- Are your staff trained in paediatric first aid?

 Yes, over 90% of our staff are paediatric first aid trained. We hold two external training workshops throughout the year to upskill any new and existing team members.
- Do you offer any extra-curricular activities?

 Yes, most of our nurseries offer extra-curricular activities such as foreign languages, sports, yoga, and dance classes. Please contact the branch for more details.
- What do I need to provide for my child?

 Please provide seasonal essentials (a sun hat and sun cream in summer; a coat, hat, and gloves in winter) and must-haves like two spare outfits, nappies (if needed), and a piece of fruit for snack time (no kiwi, grapes, or nuts). If required, bring bedding, formula, and a comforter.
- Is there a waiting list for enrolment?

 Due to high demand, some age groups may have a waiting list. Early enrolment is encouraged to secure preferred sessions. To book, please complete an application form online.
